



Hard Rock Park "Discoveries"

Hard Rock Park is not only the world's first rock 'n' roll theme park, but also a rich cross-cultural environment that features much more than world-class rides and shows. As guests explore the park, they will make a series of "discoveries" – some small and subtle, some loud and startling – that will add up to an unparalleled experience that will exceed expectations. Around nearly every corner, in between rock memorabilia and iconic imagery, unexpected surprises await.

Examples of **Hard Rock Park** "discoveries" include:

- **The Slow Mirror** – Hard Rock Park has left no corner unturned. Within the men's and women's restroom in *Rock & Roll Heaven* visitors can find "slow mirror" illusions: step up to the restroom mirror; run a comb through your hair... Two seconds later, your "reflection" does the same! Is the mirror "broken"? Has time slipped back into the past? As *America* sang: "We're seein' mirror to mirror/ Face to face/ We look but we cannot see..."
- **The Colossal Guitar Fountain** – *Rock & Roll Heaven* is home to a two-story tall, double-necked guitar inspired by the ancient Cambodian legend of a bygone race of stone deities (literally "gods of rock") that towered over mortals. Specially created for Hard Rock Park, in place of guitar strings, brass elephant heads spout narrow streams of water, that play magical musical notes when touched.
- **London Calling** – Visitors can step into one of the classic red London phone booths located throughout *British Invasion* and get far more than a 2 shilling phone call. The phones will ring every time anyone walks into a booth and will surprise guests with a crank call with a kooky twist!
- **Phantom Crystal Skull** – Is this the real thing? Or is it just fantasy? Try to touch this mesmerizing crystal skull, but your fingers pass right through the shimmering hologram as an eerie sound teases your sensibilities...
- **The Thundering Hog** – Climb on board, reach up for the handlebars, and rev 'er up! This one-of-a-kind photo opportunity allows visitors to be bikers for the day with a motorcycle that sounds – and *feels* – like the real thing! A throaty rumble and some "good vibrations" in the motorcycle's seat combine for a taste of what it's like when you're "born to be wild"!
- **The Guitar in the Stone** – The legend of Camelot takes on a rock 'n' roll twist when guests discover a golden guitar mysteriously imbedded in a massive stone. "Whoso Yanketh this Guitar from this Stone is the Right-On Ruler of Rock!" The burliest biker can't budge it, yet a small child can easily pull it away!
- **Karaoke Queue Line** – Even standing in line is a blast at Hard Rock Park. Guests waiting their turn for *Maximum RPM!* can soak up the spotlight and belt out their favorite 80's tune. Hop up on stage or sing along in place as Hard Rock Park's professional DJ keeps the crowd groovin' and the line movin'!
